Prior to joining Bathurst Resources as part of its acquisition of Eastern Corporation, Mr. Pilcher was the General Manager of New Zealand for Eastern Corporation from August 2008 to March 2011. Prior roles at Eastern Corporation also include Operations Manager of New Zealand and Marketing Manager of New Zealand.

Black diatomaceous earth will be crushed, granulated and dried at our processing facility to form granules that will be marketed under the brand name Black Pearl®. Based on the anticipated production volumes, PLAMAN Global has an operational life of at least 27 years.
